Covid-19

For your information we have included with this newsletter the latest COVID guidance if you need to isolate. Remember we are in a medium risk area:

Remember at all times: 'Hands. Face. Space'

- Wash your hands regularly and for 20 seconds.
- Wear a <u>face covering</u> in indoor settings where social distancing may be difficult, and where you will come into contact with people you do not normally meet.
- Stay two metres apart from people you do not live with where possible, or one metre with extra precautions in place, such as wearing face coverings or increasing ventilation indoors.
- Keep to the rule of 6 only 6 people are allowed in a group both inside and out.
